## Oklahoma Infrastructure Snapshot:

-  **2,326** bridges in poor condition

---

-  **1,004+** miles of highway in poor condition

---

-  **7.7%** increase in commute times since 2011

---

-  **\$394** spent per year by each driver in costs due to driving on roads in need of repair

## How Oklahoma Benefits from the Infrastructure Bill:

**\$4.6 Billion**

Federal highway formula funding for highways and bridges

▶ **27.7% MORE**

than the State's Federal-aid highway formula funding under current law.  
(On an average annual basis over 5 years)

**\$42.1 Million**

Funding to augment commercial motor vehicle (CMV) safety efforts to reduce CMV crashes through the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program (MCSAP) formula grant

▶ **44% INCREASE**

in funding compared to FAST Act levels

## National Infrastructure Grant Programs:

In addition to the \$4.6 billion in guaranteed formula funding, Oklahoma is also eligible to apply for these competitive grants:	Nationwide Total
Nationally significant freight and highway projects (AKA INFRA)	<b>\$8 billion</b>
Bridge investment program	<b>\$12.5 billion</b>
Rural surface transportation grant program	<b>\$2 billion</b>
Grants for charging and fueling infrastructure	<b>\$2.5 billion</b>
Reduction of truck emissions at port facilities	<b>\$400 million</b>
National Infrastructure Project Assistance	<b>\$10 billion</b>
Congestion relief program	<b>\$250 million</b>
Local and Regional Project Assistance (AKA RAISE/BUILD program)	<b>\$7.5 billion</b>
